Tuition includes daily lunch and snack and costs \$275 per one-week session for campers in grades K-4, \$285 per one-week session for campers in grades 5-8, and \$285 per two-week session for Bonim (formerly called CITs) in grades 9-10.

#### Discounts:

JCA members may deduct 5% per family from their total registration.

All campers registering by April 1<sup>st</sup> receive a \$10 discount per session.

- Registration forms must be accompanied by a 50% deposit.
- Full deposits will be refunded for withdrawals made by April 1<sup>st</sup>.
- A \$50 administrative fee will be deducted for withdrawals made after April 1<sup>st</sup>.
